A HISTORIAN'S VIEW: CONSPIRACISM IN THE AGE OF TRUMP



Our March 12 Luncheon speaker, Professor Bob Goldberg, received his Ph.D. from the University of Wisconsin-Madison and came to Utah in 1980. He is Professor of History and Director of the Tanner Humanities Center. Professor Goldberg is the author of eight books with his last two, Barry Goldwater, 1995, and Enemies Within: The Culture of Conspiracy in Modern America, 2005, published by Yale University Press. Just released in 2018 is his edited book with Jackson Newell and Linda Newell, Conscience and Community: Sterling M. McMurrin, Obert C.

Tanner, and Lowell L. Bennion.

Professor Goldberg has won twelve teaching honors including the Graduate Student and Postdoctoral Scholar Distinguished Mentor Award, the Calvin S. and JeNeal Hatch Prize for Teaching, Distinguished Honors Professor Award, Presidential Teaching Scholar Award, and University of Utah Distinguished Teaching Award. In 2003, he held the Fulbright Distinguished Chair in American Studies at the Swedish Institute for North American Studies, Uppsala University.

Under his directorship, the Tanner Humanities Center has raised nearly five million dollars to fund such projects as the Gateway to Learning Teacher Workshops, the World Leaders Lecture Forum, Professors off Campus Program, and the Mormon Studies Program. He was awarded the Rosenblatt Prize for Excellence in 2008.

You are invited to participate in the U of U's nationally recognized Community Partners Mentoring Program. The project places a high financial needs student with a mentor in the field the student aspires to enter. This multi-year partnership runs ideally for four years. Mentors contribute their time (about 1-2 hours/month) as well as provide a \$2,000 annual scholarship award that is directed specifically to their student. Representative professions include health sciences, law, and academia. Since its inception just five years ago, the program has grown tremendously and this year boasts 93 mentors and students, with scholarship awards totaling \$98,300. 
